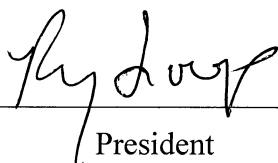
Director Reyes made a motion, seconded by Director Slovak, and the motion passed by unanimous vote for the President to sign the Old Lake Subdivision Plat.

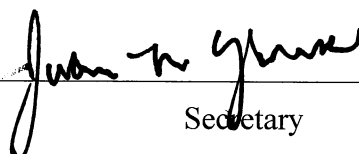
Manager Reports

- The General Manager addressed the Board of Directors regarding water availability.

- The Manager informed the Board of Directors that field staff removed the pump and motor from Unit 3. He further reported that the site has been without power for two years and has not been used for five years.
- The Manager informed the Board of Directors that field staff spread the donated recycled asphalt at the pump plant.
- The Manager informed the Board of Directors that staff installed a new motor at the Unit 8 pump station.
- The Manager informed the Board of Directors that the engineer continues to work on the standpipe structural design for the Unit 9 pipeline relocation project.
- The Manager informed the Board of Directors that staff removed two trees at the pump house after the trees were damaged by a lightning strike.
